OUR STUDENTS WERE DEEPLY MOVED AS THEY VISUALLY WITNESSED A RECREATION OF A HOLOCAUST CAMP. IT WAS A STARK REMINDER OF THE ATROCITIES ENDURED BY MILLIONS.



Death Trains

EXPERIENCING BEING PLACED IN A TIGHT DEATH TRAIN DEEPLY MOVED OUR STUDENTS. IT GAVE THEM A VISCERAL UNDERSTANDING OF THE SUFFERING ENDURED BY HOLOCAUST VICTIMS, STRENGTHENING THEIR RESOLVE TO PROMOTE TOLERANCE AND JUSTICE.



Children's Memorial

THERE ARE 1.2 MILLION HOLES OF VARYING SIZES THAT ARE DRILLED INTO STONES AFFIXED TO THE WALLS TO MEMORIALIZE THE CHILDREN KILLED DURING THE HOLOCAUST. THEY ARE OF VARYING SIZES TO SUGGEST THE DIFFERENT AGES OF THE VICTIMS. THE STUDENTS WERE FREE TO INSERT THEIR OWN SPECIAL NOTE INTO ONE OF THE 1.2 MILLION HOLES. THE NOTES WERE TO WRITE A MESSAGE TO ONE OF THE CHILDREN THAT LOST THEIR PRECIOUS LIFE DURING A DARK TIME IN HISTORY.
