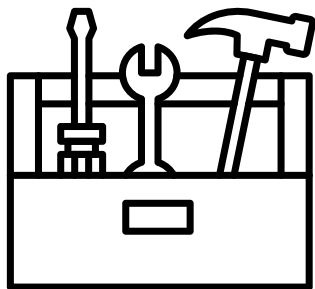
Raising Money for Senior Events

Students participated in their first day of TUPE. Mr. Aispuro presented an overview of all 6 topics they will be learning about.

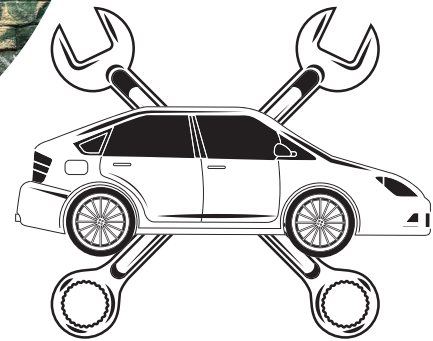


Congratulations

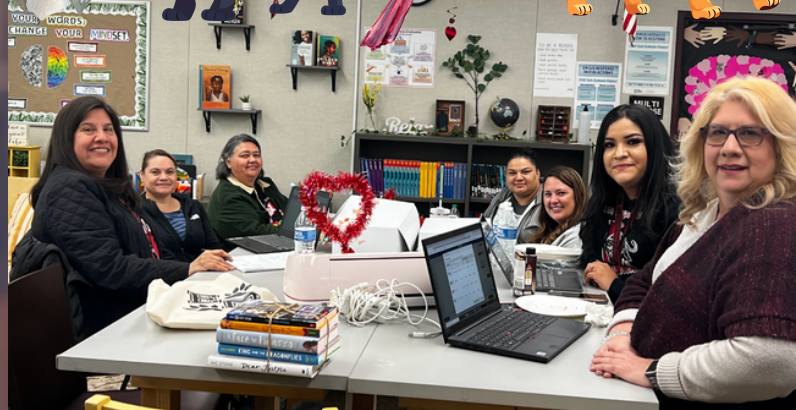
