Mr. Hosler & Mr. Diaz take us through a few AI tools they have utilized during their own personal lesson planning.

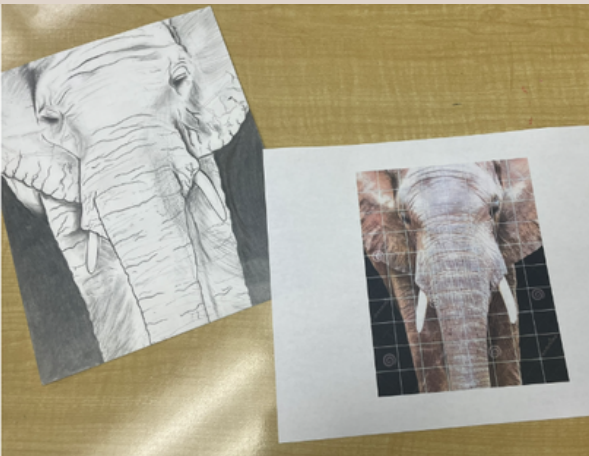

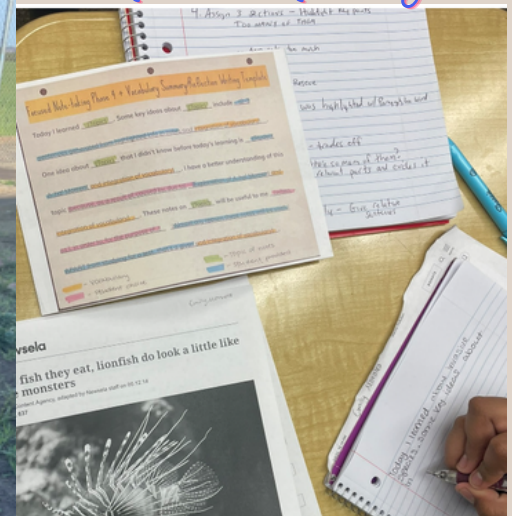
