What an amazing week of collaboration and learning! Our week started off with Extended PD where we continued our learning target and success criteria planning. Our amazing district coach, Karina Moya, facilitated this session. Diana Vides, Javier Gomez, and I take part in Tim Hire's monthly admin PLC. This month's focus was our school's alignment with our district's core values. The following day, we held our first Instructional Rounds. Thank you to fellow district colleagues for coming out and experiencing the amazing things happening on campus in and out of classes. During our Wednesday morning collaboration, our teachers split into groups and worked on the "critical friend" model for singletons. This model resembles AVID's point of confusion with a twist. Teachers share all artifacts utilized during lessons, present the data, and collaborate with their "critical friends" to identify next steps to support all students. To wrap up our week, teachers, Mr. Garnica (our counselor), and admin met one-on-one for our Focus on Learning meetings to discuss the current status of each student in their classes. We looked at their SEL needs based on the DESSA tool and observations, EL percentages in each period, SRI reading levels, and CAASPP scores. We identified students who need additional support and created a game plan to support them along with additional strategies to use in the classroom. The team will follow the same process after our Quarter 1 transfer meeting the second week of October to support new students.

Seniors work with Mr. Garnica on their CCGI Career Interest Profile. We will use this data to invite monthly and Career Day guest speakers.


