LHS Leadership won a prize for most community impact and was awarded a 1,000 dollars.

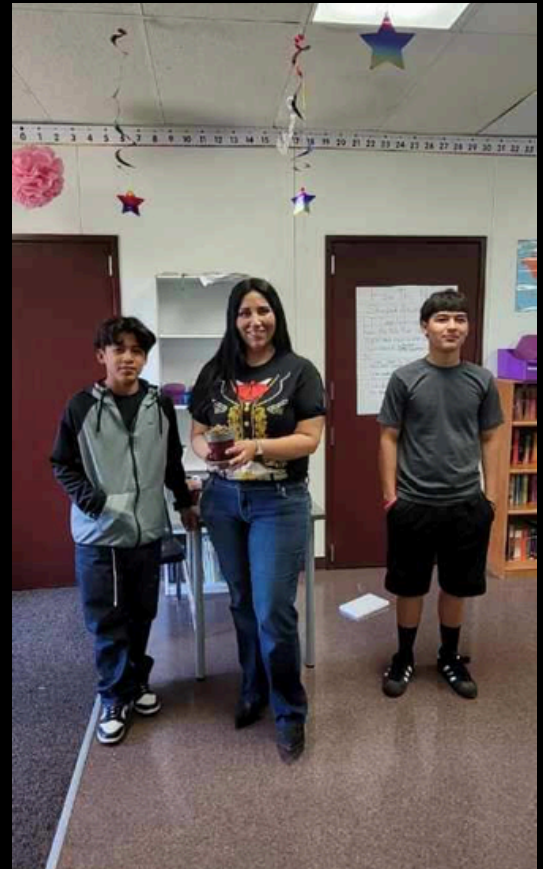

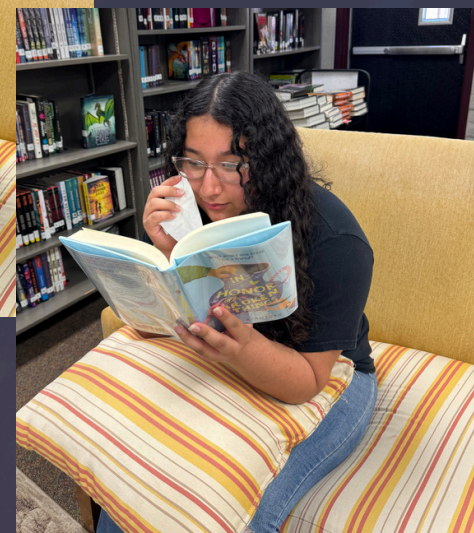

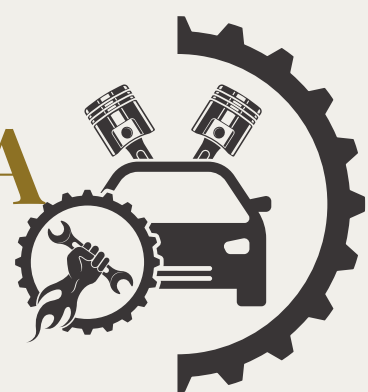
